Our many services include workshops, publications, help desk assistance, and a resource library.

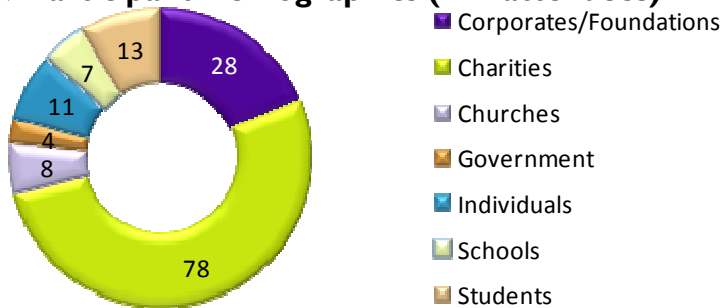

ABOUT THE THIRD SECTOR CONFERENCE

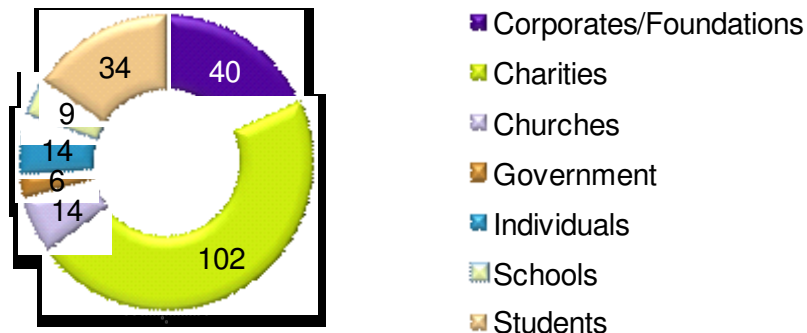

- Provide 2 professional 90 minute presentations on the agreed upon topics.
- Agree to participate in one conference call approximately 30 days before the conference.
- Provide your presentation to The Centre in an email or CD copy by February 13, 2011.
- Provide your handouts via email for duplication to The Centre by February 13, 2011. Handouts are strongly recommended.

The Centre on Philanthropy will provide:

- Complimentary Hotel Room
